 - i. Marriage certificate if married (photocopy),
- 6. High school graduates with Division I in WAEC or all As in WASSCE will be exempted from sitting the Entrance examination but must procure the application form and sit an interview; All applicants must pass in 5 subjects including Maths and English, and any other subjects relevant to their program.
- All graduates from Adventist High Schools, transferring students post-basis students and international students are exempted from sitting the entrance examination but MUST obtain the application form and sit an interview.
